



### OGCC Covid19 Net use (Revision 2 updated 15<sup>th</sup> June 2020)

We are delighted to say we now have a system that will allow nets to be available to book for OGCC members. The net use must be strictly in accordance with latest [Government rules on social distancing](#), [ECB Guidelines](#) and the following OGCC temporary rules.

- Net use is limited to “bubbles” of **Five** members from different households maintaining 2m apart at all times, or a maximum of **Six** members if exercising exclusively with household members.
- Members forming a bubble must remain in their bubble for all net sessions booked.
- Only lanes 1 (nearest the carpark) & 3 (nearest the village) can be used. The middle lane must not be used.
- Nets must be booked in advance through the online system, see details below.
- Net use is limited to fully paid up club members only and limited to 1 net session per member per day (excluding training). Non-club members are not to be invited to use the nets.
- Players must only use their own equipment and must ensure it is clean and safe to use.
- There is no access to the cricket store. No club equipment or property to be used, including the use of the bowling machine, stumps etc (please do not use club bins for stumps either).
- The clubhouse will continue to be closed and no facilities will be available. Personal hygiene measures should be carried out at home before and after net use.
- Members are required to take all rubbish home after their net session.
- All usual net rules apply including: no spikes; no un-supervised use for under 16's; full protection to be worn for hardball cricket etc.

All bookings to be made via <https://ogcc.skedda.com/>. With your first booking you will be required to complete registration with contact details including email and phone. Each booking session must be titled with all the players names using the net. Booking start times are limited to 9AM to 7PM and each session booked will be confirmed by email on a first come, first served basis. E-mail confirmation to be used as proof of booking. Club training session will take priority over personal bookings.

Each booking is for a 1 hour session but nets must be vacated 10 minutes prior to the end of the session, to allow a 10 minute gap between bookings. Please wait away from the nets, or in cars prior to the start of your session. The car park will be locked overnight for security reasons.

In the interest of allowing all members fair access to the net facility the club reserve the right to impose restrictions or cancel any bookings without prior notice. Anyone found to be using the facilities without booking or not complying with [Government rules on social distancing](#), [ECB Guidelines](#) and OGCC rules will be told to stop using the nets and may face club disciplinary action. Antisocial behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in nets being closed for all.

Enjoy the net use, stay safe and alert. If in doubt use Covid common sense. Any damage to nets, or inappropriate use to be reported to the club committee members.
